Interior Lighting

Lighting is dictated by the heat type you select, generally speaking.

Standard traditional saunas place LED Light Strips in the backrests and/or under benches for a soft, relaxing ambience. Alternatively, in a traditional sauna you can opt for ceiling puck lights. Infrared saunas only utilize ceiling puck lights. Both lighting options offer white and RGBW (colored) light to illuminate your sauna.



TRADITIONAL INFRARED

CHROMOTHERAPY IN YOUR SAUNA

Also known as color therapy, chromotherapy uses certain colors to aid in healing and well-being – physical, psychological, and emotional. Elevate your sauna experience by basking in the color best suited to your wellness and relaxation.



Red is the symbol of love and life itself. With its penetration power, which is the highest of all colors, it is recommended for treatment of impeded circulation, benefiting muscles and heart. It generates enthusiasm, arouses passion, and has a cheering effect.



GREEN

Green is a cool, serene color, which is known to help reduce swelling of joints and tissues. It calms the body and helps reduce inflammation.



TURQUOISE

The color for mental relaxation and tackling embedded psychological barriers. It can help regulate imbalances in the lung and large intestines. It is a color that facilitates spiritual growth.





MAGENTA

Promoting awareness and consciousness, magenta increases the effects of meditation. It also promotes proper functioning of the lymphatic system and is very helpful in times of menopause. Magenta is the color for neutralizing emotional wounds and for spiritual growth.



Another cool color with a calming effect, blue is helpful in treating sleep disorders and headaches. It helps in all kinds of cramps and can have an anti-bacterial effect.





- 1. Lowest EMR/EF Exposure Available: Our PureInfra[™] infrared technology nearly eliminates the minimal radiation present in all infrared saunas. At low levels EMR and EF radiation isn't considered harmful, but we wanted to make the safest solution possible. Our patented PureInfra[™] technology reduces the EMR level throughout the entire sauna room (no radiation spikes, ever) to below 2 mG and EF below 1 Vm; this is measured at the point of body contact.
- 2. Even Heat Distribution: Hot and cold spots are eliminated with our CarbonFlex® emitters. Always—on technology and full—coverage installation techniques combine to create the most soothing, full—body heat exposure. Maximize your wellness time in a sauna with the tech that produces heat that safely heals, relaxes, detoxifies, and purifies.

Ø INFRARED ENERGY & ROOM TEMP

In an infrared sauna, light energy is emitted; this is your source of healing and heat. As you heat bathe, this energy will raise your core body temperature – which is the goal in an infrared sauna. In order to do this, the emitter panels must remain 'on' which happens as your sauna works toward your set temperature. All that being said, the room temperature will rise as a side effect of the light energy filling the space, and your heat bath is more enjoyable if your room is warm – a general recommended room temperature is 120°–130°.

Ø PROXIMITY TO EMITTER PANELS

6" or closer; the closer you are to emitter panels, the better, so that the infrared energy can penetrate your skin. For this reason we line as many surfaces as thoroughly as possible to bring the emitters close to you.





Sauna installation and finishing touches require some additional planning and preparation:

- Framed & Prepped Space for Sauna (Indoor or Outdoor), including subfloor & foundation work
- Installation of: stud walls (or furring strips), ceiling joists, and insulation.
- Finish Painting / Staining of Exterior Surfaces (Primarily Outdoor)
- Electrical Wiring, including connections to control
- Materials & Construction of Design Elements Outside Finnleo's Expertise (I.e. All-Glass Walls)

Code Requirements: All materials, components, and work shall conform to all applicable local, state, and federal building safety codes, ordinances, and regulations.

CEILING HEIGHT

We recommend 7' ceilings to maximize heater efficiency and sauna bather comfort. Heat stratification allows the warmest temperatures at the highest point in the room, so ceiling heights >7' negatively impact temperature at bench level.

₩ WALL FRAMING

16" on center. Standard framed walls should have 2"x4" studs, bottom base plate treated, and ceiling lowered to 84" I.D. from floor to framing. Existing masonry walls should have furring strips 16" on center, metal studs need furring strips for nailing of tongue-and-groove wall boards.

FLOORING

Cement, ceramic tile, or similar waterproof flooring required. (No carpet.)

POWER


Reference owner's manual for selected heater/panels for specific power requirements.

INSULATION

R11 rated fiberglass insulation recommended.

All sauna room components are fully warranted for 1 year. Heaters & controls have a 5-year limited warranty (1-year for Commercial) against defects in material and workmanship. See your dealer for more information.


