



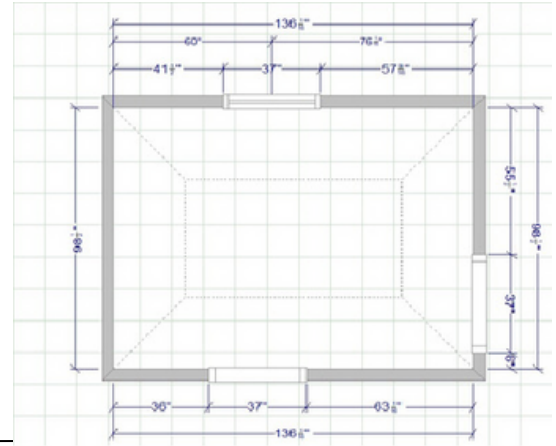
MEASURE A KITCHEN

Use this guide as a starting point for the dimensions of your kitchen.

01

OUTLINE THE ROOM

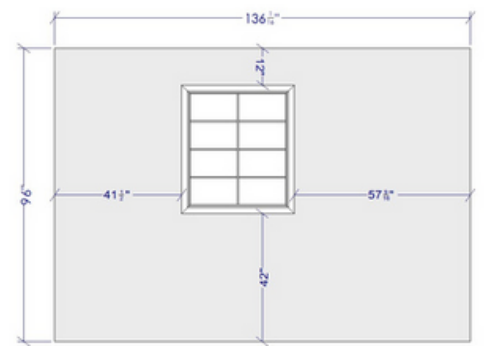
Give a rough idea of the shape of the room. Draw any windows, doors, and any wall bump-outs.

MEASURE WINDOWS & DOORS

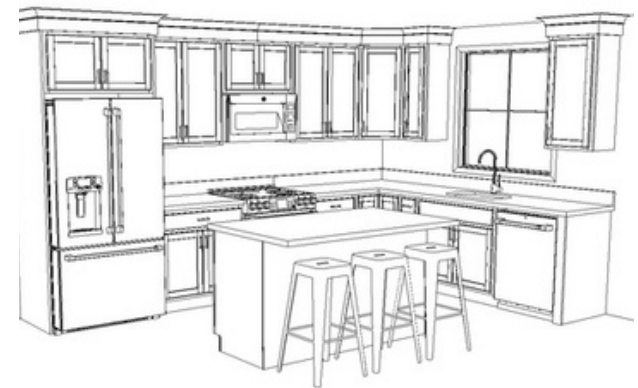
Measure outside edge to outside edge, INCLUDING the trim.



03

MEASURE CEILING HEIGHT

Measure floor to ceiling. If there's a soffit (or other obstruction) also measure from floor to the base of the soffit.

NOTE THE DETAILS

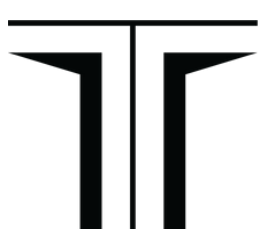
Be sure to note important items like light switches, outlets, vents, pipes, etc.

PLAN FOR APPLIANCES

If you plan on keeping existing appliances, measure their height, depth, and width or write down the model number.

If you plan on purchasing new appliances, be sure to let us know what you choose so we can design for them.
